Installation Notes

You could install the DocumentsCorePack Server for Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2013 on any supported operating system which is able to connect to your CRM 2013 Server.

During the installation, you have to specify at least one organization in which the DocumentsCorePack Server will be installed. After the setup is completed, you could start the DocumentsCorePack Server Configuration in the Windows Start-menu to install and configure the DocumentsCorePack Server in another CRM organization.

In an **On-Premise** environment, you have to install the "Server Part" on the CRM Server.

If you want to use **DocumentsCorePack** with **CRM Online** you can install the "Server Part" also on any other supported OS.

Uninstall

If you want to completely uninstall the DocumentsCorePack Server for Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2013 for all CRM organizations, just start the uninstall routine through Windows Programs and Features.

If you want to uninstall the DocumentsCorePack Server for Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2013 for one specific CRM organization, you have could start the DocumentsCorePack Server Configuration from the Start-menu, select the organization and click on "Uninstall".

Known Issue for RTM
