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How to work with DocumentsCorePack Online Dynamics 365

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Preamble

This documentation is intended to guide you through the installation and usage of DocumentsCorePack Online Configuration for Microsoft Dynamics 365.

Target Audience

This guide is intended for users applying search queries with DocumentsCorePack who have the following minimum skills:

- Basic Microsoft Dynamics CRM Knowledge
- Maintaining and configuring a Microsoft CRM Organization

Purpose of DocumentsCorePack Online Configuration

The DocumentsCorePack Online Configuration has many advantages, one of them being the reason that a local server is not required anymore. This means, that precious storage space is saved on your local server, while all ServerBased features of the add-ons are available. Furthermore, the services are hosted and updated by our support team.

1 Basics on Online Configuration

This documentation is divided into three parts. While the first part is filled with basic information on the online configuration, which is the same for DocumentsCorePack and AttachmentExtractor, part 2 and 3 of this documentation focus clearly on the differences between DocumentsCorePack and AttachmentExtractor.

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Next to this documentation, we do provide video tutorials for <u>DocumentsCorePack</u> that show how to start the Online Configuration step by step.

Also, you can find further information regarding the DocumentsCorePack Online Configuration here.

1.1 How to start the Online Configuration

Start the Online Configuration for DocumentsCorePack by selecting the product and following the steps below.

1.1.1 Step 1: Open the Online Configuration Service for DocumentsCorePack

One possible way to start a new Online Service Configuration is via our website <u>www.mscrm-addons.com</u>. On our website, please navigate to Products, select DocumentsCorePack (depends on which product you would like to configure) and then, click on the **[Start Tial (Service Setup)]**-button.




Figure 2: Login to mscrm-addons.com

1.1.3 The Online Configuration window

1.2 How to setup an MS Dynamics 365 Online Service for DocumentsCorePack

First, a connection to MS Dynamics 365 must be established via the CRM connection profile, which is required to connect Microsoft Dynamics 365 Online with your Microsoft Dynamics 365 organization.

Once you have setup your connection, you are ready to set up a DocumentsCorePack Service.

Look for further information on the setup of the configuration in CHAPTER 2, ADVANCED ONLINE CONFIGURATION.



To establish the connection for DocumentsCorePack, please note that admin rights are required.

2 THE [ADD]-BUTTON

Please click on this button to add a new service. Next, click on the **[Connection Profile]**-button. In the so opened window, please enter your settings and click on the **[Verify Connection & Save Profile]**-button in the right lower corner. 3 The **[Manage]**-BUTTON

Click here to modify the MS Dynamics 365 service and connection profile. Alternatively, you could doubleclick on the service you would like to modify. You will be provided with the details of your MS Dynamics 365 Online service and connection profile (please also see picture 7).

PLEASE NOTE

If a service is currently used by a DocumentsCorePack Service Configuration, you will only be allowed to change the user credentials. Also, you must select the same organization.

4 THE [DELETE]-BUTTON

If you do not need your Online service anymore, please click here to delete it. If you try to delete a service.

1. ADD A NEW DOCUMENTSCOREPACK SERVICE OR CONFIGURE AN EXISTING ONE

Simply click on the **[Add]**-button (+) in order to create a new DocumentsCorePack Service.



One user can only be added to one service, for example: if user A has a service for one organization, user B cannot be added to the same organization.

2. CONFIGURE CLOUD PRINT

Once you have created a CRM Connection profile, the printing options can be specified here. Please make sure that you have already configured your Cloud Printers previously. Once configured, you can access printers from Power Automate, Dynamics 365 or your PowerApp.

3. CONFIGURE LOAD BALANCING

Select your Load Balancer Configuration here.

7. VIEW VERSION INFO

A click on this button opens the *Version Information* window. Here, you get an overview on your license. With a click on the *[Reinstall/Upgrade]*-button, you can as well reinstall or upgrade your license.

10. IMPORT/EXPORT DOCUMENTSCOREPACK TEMPLATES

This Template Management window opens Where you can

• Import DocumentsCorePack Templates: Here, you will be asked to specify how to proceed with the templates you import, but that already exist in the system. You have the possibility to select between the following three options:

Overwrite - The template GUID stays the same.

- *Import the new version* The 'old' version will be kept with the 'old' template GUID and the 'new' version of the template will be imported with a 'new' template GUID.
- Ignore All existing templates will be ignored. Only new templates will be imported.
- Export DocumentsCorePack Templates as *.zip-files.
- Transfer DocumentsCorePack Templates to another organization
- Enable a Scheduled Template Backup to Azure Blob Storage

2.2 The DocumentsCorePack Service Configuration surface

The DCP Online Service Configuration service helps you to create a new service. The surface is divided into two different parts – the basic and the advanced options.

2.2.1 The basic DocumentsCorePack configuration options

Using this section by pressing the **[+]**-button, you can configure the basic options of your service. In general, setting the basic options is enough to start a service.

1. SET UP YOUR CRM CONNECTION

Set up a connection profile. Learn later more.

2. SERVICE NAME

Please enter your service name here. But choose wise because the name cannot be changed anymore!

3. DOCUMENTSCOREPACK INSTANCE

Please select the instance on which the service should be installed. The instance with the best bandwidth is automatically preselected, but you can change it until you have saved the new service.

4. JOB TYPE

Specify here which jobs should be processed by the service. Print Jobs, Document Generation jobs or both are selectable. When selecting Print Jobs only, you can apply a filter.

5. Use CRM INTEGRATED SHAREPOINT

Enable this setting when the documents should be stored in the CRM integrated SharePoint. Otherwise, the documents will be stored as note attachments.

6. SHOW ADVANCED OPTIONS

A click on this button expands some options for the advanced configuration

1. PUSH REQUEST LOGIC

Specify which Push Request Logic should be used by the DCP Dialog.

2. ENABLE DEBUGGING

In case of any issues during the document generation, we would recommend you enable debugging here. The log files will be available as soon as the service is saved.

3. NOTIFY ON SERVICE CHANGES

Select this option to receive an e-mail every time there is a service change.

4. SHAREPOINT SINGLE LOCATION

Specify a SharePoint location for document edits even when no SharePoint integration is enabled within the CRM.

5. FORCE THIS SERVICE TO BE THE ONLY DOCUMENT-GENERATING SERVICE

If you select this option, this will be the only service which processes your documents.

6. CATEGORY

Number category for prioritization. Required when using multiple services. Default is 0.

7. SERVER VERSION

This field informs you about the current DocumentsCorePack version of your instance.

8. SHOW EVEN MORE ADVANCED OPTIONS

A click on this button expands some options for the advanced configuration.



If you feel that the configuration so far satisfies your needs, you can save your service now with a click on the **[Save Service]**-button in the right lower corner. But of course, the service can as well be configured on an advanced level, which can be done in the Advanced Configuration-section. 1. ONLY COUNT USERS WITH SECURITY ROLE FOR LICENSING

This Feature was enabled to deal with a common issue that all users with an assigned Dynamics 365 will automatically become enabled users in every Dynamics 365 tenant and thus counts towards our license although the users have no access to the tenant. Once enabled our licensing will count users only if they have at least one security role assigned which is not the case for auto-signed users from the Office 365 Portal.

2. SKIP SOLUTION IMPORT

If you select this option, the setup will assume that you already import all of your solutions that are necessary for a creation of a service. if a particular solution is missing, the creation of the new service will fail.

3. SKIP ROLE ASSIGNMENT

If you select this option, you either have to create a custom role covering the required rights or you will have to manually assign the security roles.

4. SYNCHRONOUS SOLUTION IMPORT

If you select this option, the setup will try to import the solutions synchronously.

5. Use sharepoint compatibility connection

If you use this option a compatibility SharePoint connection will be used.

6. SAVE SERVICE BUTTON

It is necessary to press this button in order to save your configurations!

Before you can setup a service, you must create a CRM connection profile. Please follow the below stepby-step tutorial in order to start an Online Service properly.

3.1.2 Step 2: Setup a connection profile

If you already have a connection profile, you can skip this step and continue with creating a service for DocumentsCorePack or AttachmentExtractor. You will find a detailed description of this in the following chapters.

1 Select your connection type. For the online service it is Server2Server.

2 Type in your CRM URL

3 Press the [Retrieve Organizations]-button




Figure 22: Log in




