## AE Server for Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2015/2016/D365 Prerequisites

#### Microsoft .NET Framework 4.6.2 (Full) is required

The full version of Microsoft .NET Framework 4.6.2 is required. Client Runtime is not sufficient.

- Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2015 RTM On Premise
- Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2015 RTW Online
- Microsoft Dynamics Hosted (IFD)

### Windows Identity Foundation

Will be installed as part of the AttachmentExtractor Server Setup

#### Supported Operating Systems

Windows Server 2008 R2 or higher Internet Explorer 10 or higher

#### Installation Notes

You could install the **AttachmentExtractor Server for Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2015/2016/D365** on any supported operating system which is able to connect to your CRM 2015/2016/D365 Server, but it will have a speed reduction.

During the installation, you must specify at least one organization in which the AttachmentExtractor Server will be installed. After the setup is completed, you could start the AttachmentExtractor Server Configuration in the Windows Start-menu to install and configure the AttachmentExtractor Server for another CRM organization.

In an **On-Premise** or **IFD/Partner Hosted** environment, you must install the "Server Part" on the CRM Server to get access to the full functionality. Installing on a different machine will only offer reduced product functionality after installation.

#### Uninstall

If you want to completely uninstall the AttachmentExtractor Server for Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2015/2016/D365 for all CRM organizations, just start the uninstall routine through Windows Programs and Features. If you want to uninstall the AttachmentExtractor Server for Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2015/2016/D365 for one specific CRM organization, launch the AttachmentExtractor configuration and remove the product from the desired organization.
